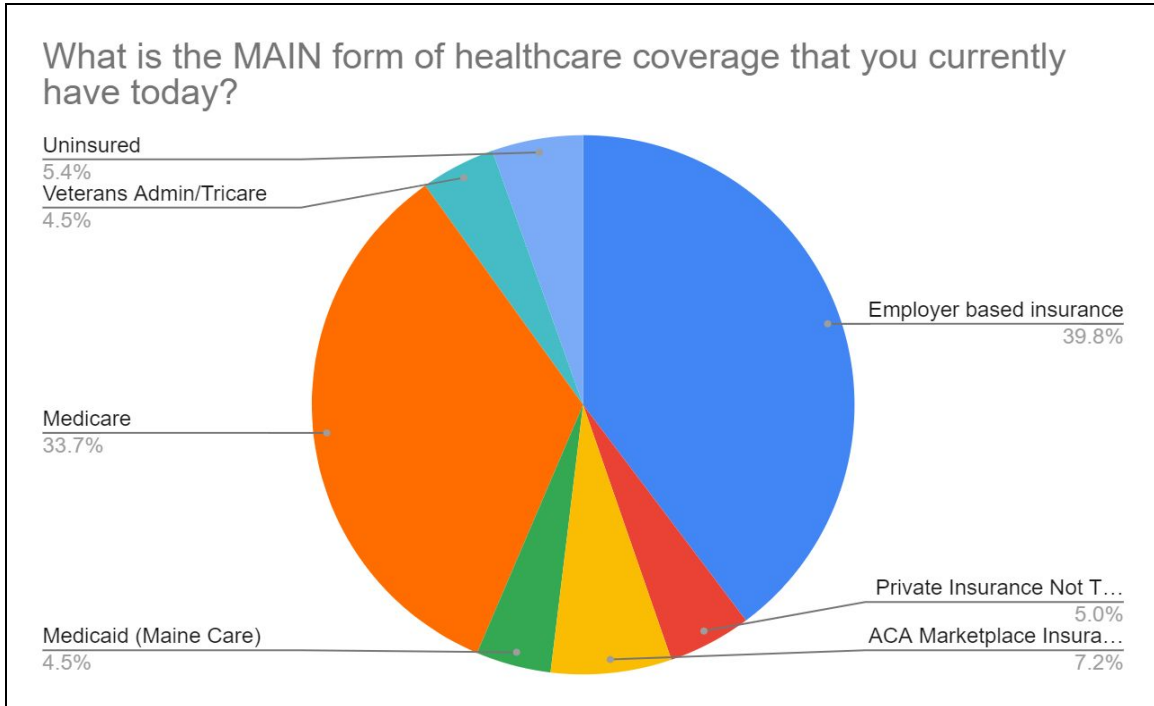


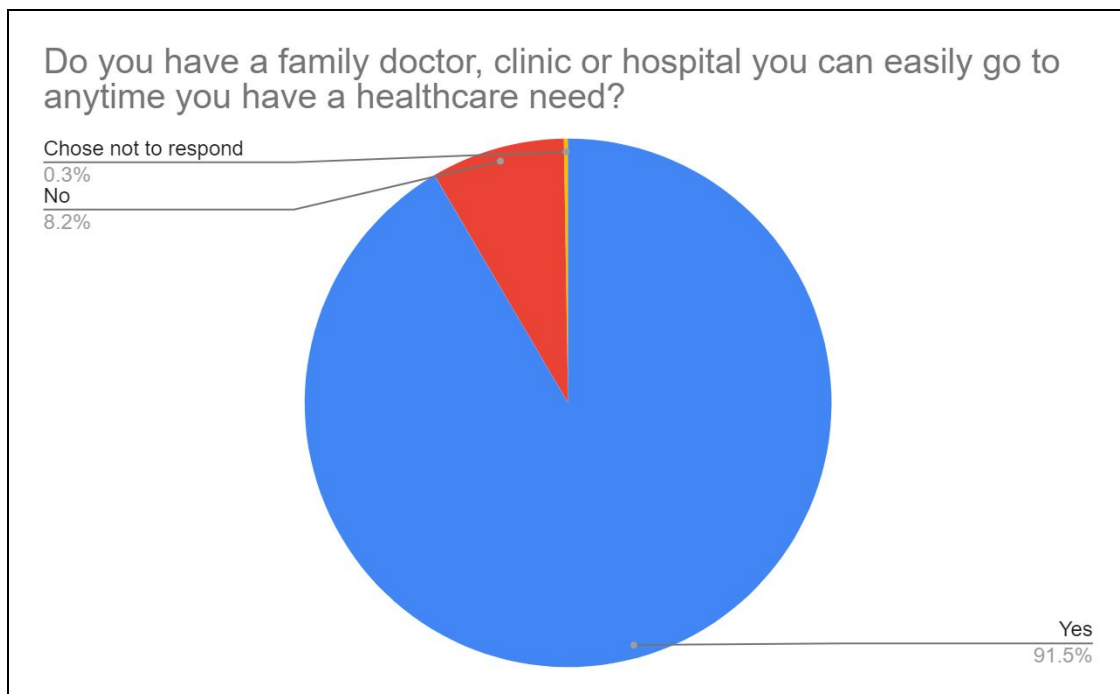
Q1. What is the MAIN form of healthcare coverage that you currently have today?

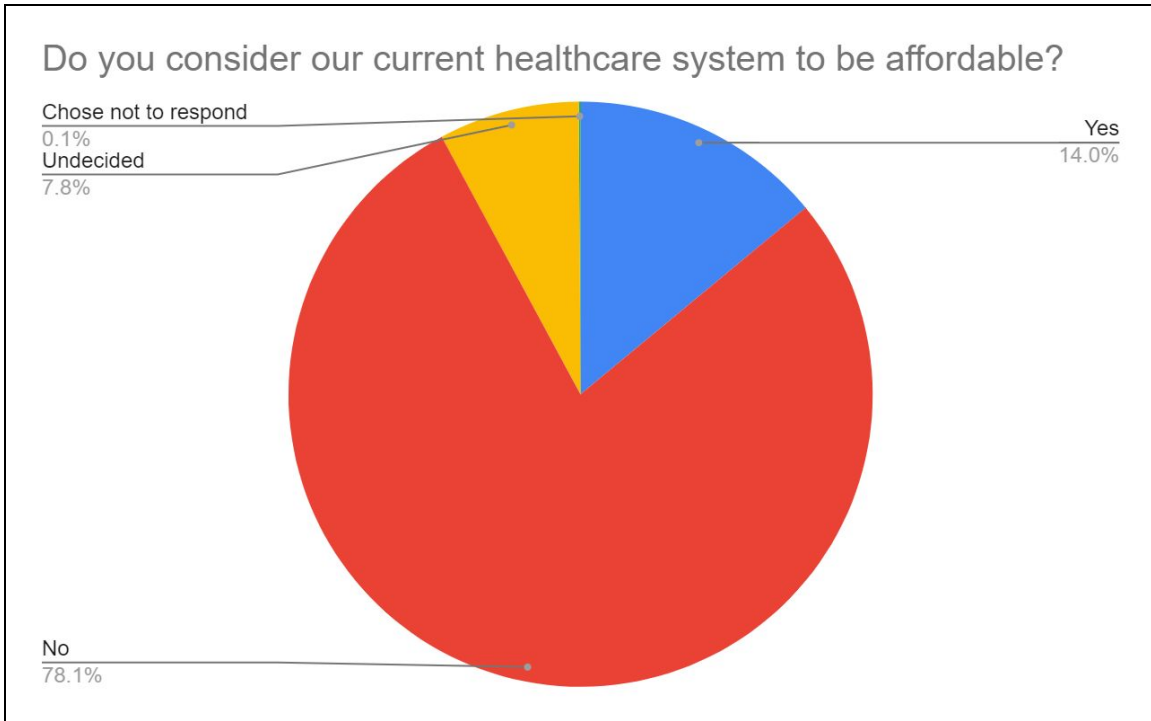
Q3. Do you consider our current healthcare system to be affordable?

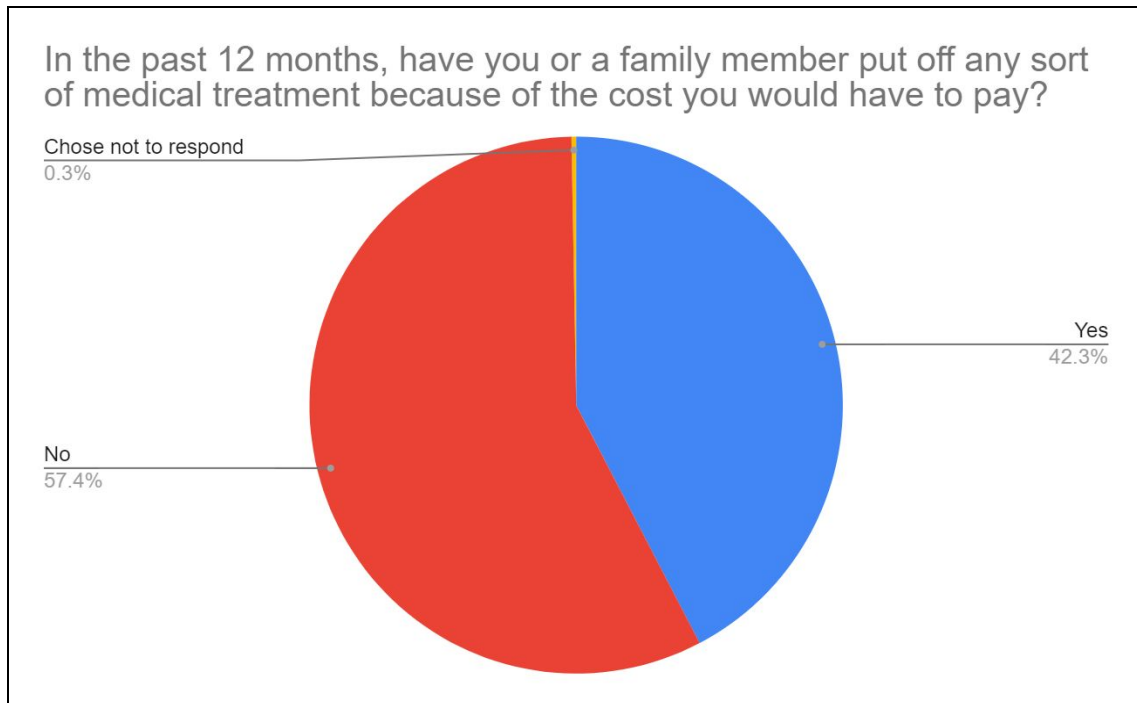


Q4. In the past 12 months, have you or a family member put off any sort of medical treatment because of the cost you would have to pay?

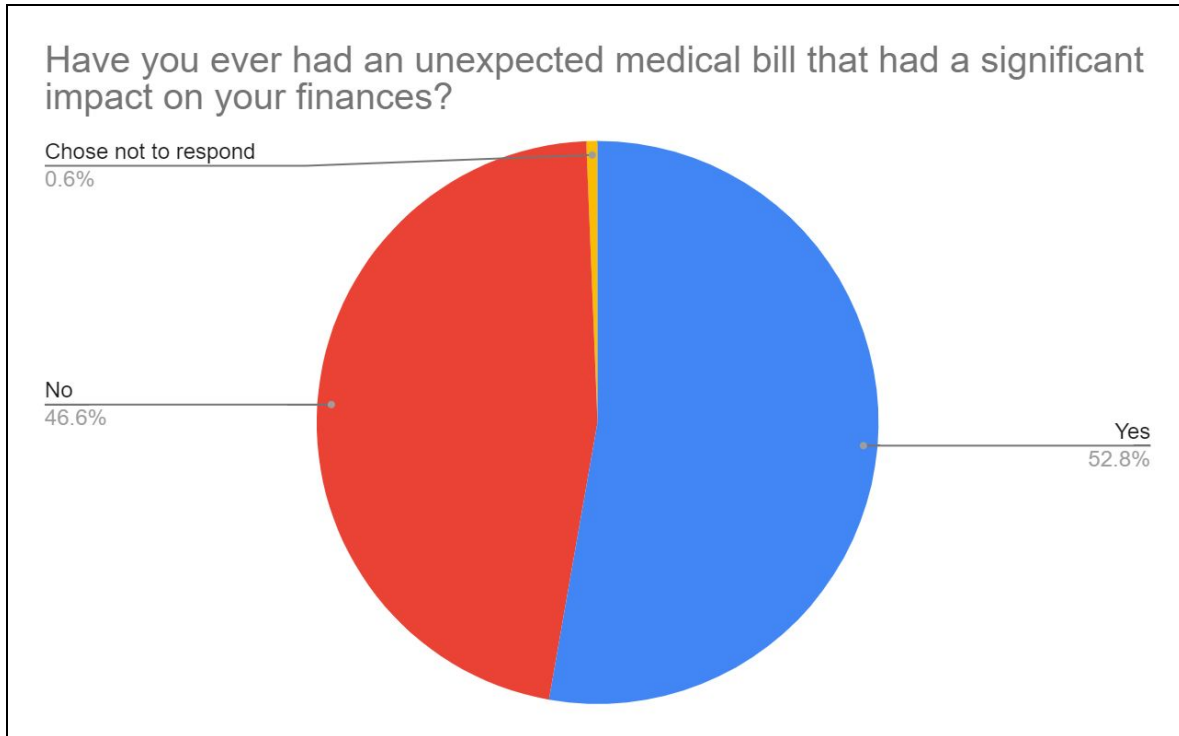


Q5. Have you ever had an unexpected medical bill that had a significant impact on your finances?

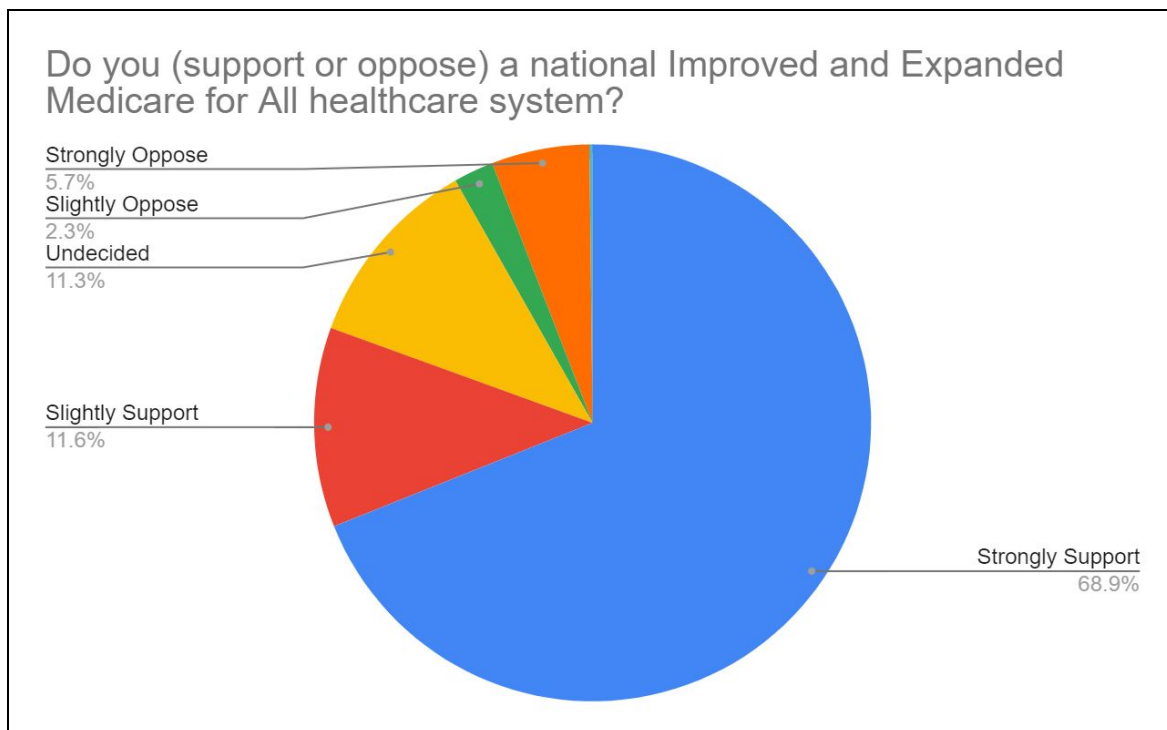
