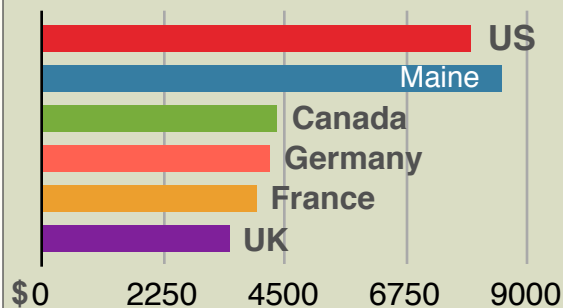
WHO WE ARE

Guiding Principles

EVERYONE IN ONE PLAN

A single, universal health care plan that covers everyone, offering the same comprehensive benefits to all Maine residents.

AFFORDABLE AND EQUITABLE

Universal health care will be financed by a broad mix of premiums, taxes and small co-pays, based on an individual's ability to pay. This approach will minimize the burden on any one sector. A viable funding mechanism will be determined by the political process to ensure it is affordable, equitable, stable, and sustainable.

MISSION, NOT MONEY DRIVEN

Health care in America has drifted away from its healing roots and toward a corporate enterprise that views patients as consumers, and a source for ever-increasing profits. Maine AllCare is working to return health care to its real mission – maintaining health and healing the sick.

EMPHASIS ON PREVENTION

Preventive services will be integrated with primary care to assure early detection and treatment of problems. Maine AllCare promotes health maintenance, encouraging individuals toward healthy lifestyle choices.

CHOICE OF PROVIDER

Mainers will be able to choose any doctor, clinic, hospital or other health service provider. Doctors and patients would regain autonomy over patient care. Decisions about an individual's health care would be made solely by the patient and his/her doctor, not outside parties.

FOCUS ON EFFICIENCY

Electronic patient and billing records will be implemented as secure systems, greatly reducing administrative costs, minimizing errors, and facilitating coordination of care. Doctors and all other health care providers will be paid promptly and accurately, based on negotiated rates.
